TO PORTAGE LAKE ASSOCIATION MEMBERS:

Our Hubbard County Coalition of Lake Associations (COLA) group, in cooperation with Hubbard County Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD), makes plants available to member associations' property owners in an effort to "Restore the Shore". Increasing vegetative cover in the shoreland "buffer zone" (an area roughly 25-50 feet nearest the water) protects water quality, helps prevent erosion, decreases flood intensity, filters nutrient and pollutant runoff and enhances wildlife habitat. This on-going COLA program was initiated in 1999 by Jerry Knoblich and the late Frank Smith.

Individuals may order directly from the SWCD at then-current prices, but must get each species/type in bundles of 25. **Using COLA's program, the minimum order is just five (5) of each type.**

REMEMBER... BIODIVERSITY!!! SWCD offers bundles of assorted types intended for different "niches" (wetland, wildlife, upland) or, order just some of those types in lots of 5 or more).

TO ORDER: complete the attached WHITE order form (provided by SWCD); select the species, calculate costs and the total, then add MN sales tax. **Make your check payable to Portage Lake Association and give the form to Jerry Knoblich by Sept. 15, 2009.** Keep a copy for your records. COLA will combine the orders and forward the "package" to the SWCD.

Approximately May 1, 2010 these bare-root (with no soil ball) seedlings/transplants will be shipped from contracted nurseries to SWCD, sorted and bundled for COLA, and then sorted and repacked by COLA volunteer(s) for your "Restore the Shore" coordinator. Be sure your group's coordinator knows where to contact you at that time!

Keep your seedlings cool and moist; plant them as soon as possible; protect the roots from sun and wind. Plant into areas relatively free of competing vegetation, especially grasses.
